Georgia Opioid Crisis Abatement Trust to Close 2025 Grant Application Period on June 18

ATLANTA—The Georgia Opioid Crisis Abatement Trust is reminding applicants that the 2025 grant application portal will close on Tuesday, June 18. With less than a week remaining, eligible organizations are encouraged to complete and submit their applications as soon as possible at www.gaopioiitrust.org.

“These funds are a lifeline for Georgia’s communities,” said Kevin Tanner, Trustee of the Georgia Opioid Crisis Abatement Trust. “We’re starting to see the real impact of these dollars in communities across Georgia, and I’m excited to see how this year’s funds help communities combat the opioid crisis. I encourage all eligible applicants to take this final opportunity to seek funding that will strengthen prevention, treatment and recovery efforts in their region.”

Applicants must submit all materials through the online portal by 8:00 p.m. on June 18, 2025.

In its second year of funding, the Trust anticipates making up to \$30 million available for competitive grant awards during this application cycle. Applicants may seek funding for initiatives in the following categories:

- Prevention and Education
- Treatment and Recovery
- Harm Reduction and Outreach
- Infrastructure and Workforce Development
- Law Enforcement and First Responder Education and Training
- Data and Evaluation

Combined with the \$70.3 million awarded in 2024, the Trust anticipates bringing the total allocation to more than \$100 million in local and statewide strategies to combat the opioid crisis.

To support applicants, the Trust launched a series of statewide training workshops in early May and provides an extensive suite of resources online—including toolkits, application guidance, FAQs, and a recorded application training session.
