The Opioid Crisis Abatement Trust and the Georgia Sheriffs' Association will host a signing ceremony to mark a two-year, \$408,000 grant aimed at youth education and prevention.

The funding will help expand the CHAMPS (Choosing Healthy Activities and Methods Promoting Safety) program, which educates Georgia's youth on the dangers of opioid misuse and substance abuse. It will provide resources for training deputies, expanding curriculum, and increasing outreach across the state.
